



**UNITED WAY OF ELIZABETHTON/CARTER COUNTY
2016-2017**

Each United Way is independent, governed by a local board of volunteers and raises funds through a single community wide campaign. United Way of Elizabethton/Carter County was organized and chartered in 1981.

United Way of Elizabethton/Carter County supports seven member agencies and two community action partners. Every member receiving funds is non-profit, tax exempt, a charity, governed by volunteers, has annual CPA audits or reviews, has bonded financial officers and maintains a policy of non-discrimination. The agencies depend on budgeted amount to operate. The agencies receive their annual allocation in twelve equal payments, allowing time for payroll deductions to reach the office.

Donor options allow individuals to designate a portion or all of their pledge to another United Way, non-member agencies or member agencies. Carter County residents working in another county may designate their pledge to come back to the United Way of Elizabethton/Carter County or an agency in the county by indicating their wishes on the pledge card.

One part-time employee maintains the local United Way office. The Board of Directors consists of volunteers from the community. They conduct, collect and monitor the campaign and the funds raised. Quarterly reports are submitted to both the Board of Directors and the IRS. An annual audit is conducted. State and Federal reports and agency files are maintained and updated by the staff.
